**Certificate III in Disability
(CHC30408)**

Certificate III in Disability is a nationally recognised qualification for people who provide care and support to people with disabilities.

Workers in this occupational group work in the community and/or residential facilities under direct or regular supervision within clearly defined organisational guidelines and service plans.

These workers carry out activities related to the maintenance of an individual's personal care and/ or other activities of living. These workers report directly to a supervisor and are not responsible for other workers.

Workers at this level are required to have an understanding of Indigenous culture and history and to work with local communities in the provision of services.

If you currently work in industry and have significant experience you may be able to complete the Certificate within a shorter timeframe through a combination of recognition of current competency and workplace based learning.

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To gain a national qualification you need to prove competence in 10 compulsory and 4 elective units.
