Disability Work
(CHC40302)

Certificate IV in Disability Work is a Nationally recognised qualification for people who provide care and support to people with a disability.

Occupations include: Co-ordinators, Social Educators, Project Officers, Senior Personal Care Assistants.

You will apply knowledge and skills gained to provide training and support to people with disabilities to encourage them to achieve greater levels of self reliance, independence, and community participation.

You may report to service managers and liaise with health professionals and other service agencies.

You may work without direct supervision and be required to supervise and/or co-ordinate a limited number of lower classified workers.

Workers at this level are required to have an understanding of Indigenous culture and history and to work with local communities in the provision of services.
